The county council has developed a new Passenger Transport Policy and Strategy (PTPS) to ensure its passenger transport provision is fit for purpose and cost-effective.

We are reviewing all contracted services across the county. The review of service 7 is now complete and the intended course of action is to retain a bus service with a reduced timetable.
