## COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT MEETING

Passenger transport is changing in Leicestershire and, at the same time as the county council is facing significant financial challenges, we are also trying to offer a better service to residents. The county council has developed a new Passenger Transport Policy and Strategy (PTPS) to ensure its passenger transport provision is fit for purpose and cost-effective.

We are reviewing all contracted services across the county. The review of service 7 is now complete and the intended course of action is to retain a bus service with a reduced timetable.

The council would like to engage with affected communities on the outcome of the review and the intended course of action.
