The \*Wildflower Patch is made up of:

**500g of (100% flowers) Bee Wildflower Seed Mix**

*\*'Grown without the use of peat, fungicides or pesticides'*

All of the wildflower seed in the mixes are UK origin and provenance – they are from UK stock and harvested in the UK. Our particular seeds are from a Warwickshire business.
