RE: A5 westbound Dordon to M42 junction 10 resurfacing.

What we're doing and why? What are the benefits?

We'll be resurfacing the A5 westbound between Dordon and the M42 junction 10. The completed work will provide a new road surface, with clearer road markings ensuring safer journeys for all road users.

When will this work take place?

We'll work from **20 April 2020 to 5 June 2020, Monday to Friday, 8pm to 6am**. However, this is subject to adverse weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

What does this mean for you?

The work will be carried out overnight when traffic is lower to reduce the impact on your journeys. To conduct the work safely, we'll need to close the A5 westbound between Dordon and the M42 junction 10.

During closures, we'll provide a fully signed diversion route which will include a motorway and non-motorway diversion. Access to businesses and residents will be maintained.

I would also like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disruption to those living close to the work. We'll make every effort to carefully manage noise levels and additional lighting to minimise the impact.
